In a world where machines can drive cars, land spacecraft, and compose sonnets, how do we harness this technology to create a more just and humane world? Professor Chris Brooks will help us to understand AI history, definitions, benefits and concerns, present some ways in which AI can be used to address educational equity and improve learning outcomes, and ask how we can reconsider AI to mean 'augmented intelligence', and whether this reframing can let us place human needs and concerns at the center of the design.

**Christopher Brooks** is a professor in the Department of Computer Science at USF, with a joint appointment in the Department of Engineering. He joined USF in 2002 after



# Embracing the Mission: A Resource Guide


